Directions to Legends

Follow the QEW towards Fort Erie. **DO NOT** take Hwy 405 to Queenston Heights!

Exit at Lyons Creek Road [Exit #21]. After you exit the highway, turn left (East) at the stop sign (crossing over top of QEW).

Follow past the small town of Chippawa (smaller than Delhi!). Stay on this road until it ends at the Niagara River. Veer to the right and follow along the Niagara Parkway for 4 km's. The entrance is on the right. The driveway to the clubhouse is approximately 1 km and the parking lot will be on your left past the Clubhouse. A shuttle bus will pick you up in the parking lot and take you to your golf cart and sign in with the Marshall.

Watch for the blue signs along the QEW. They will direct you to the course.

It is approximately 30 km from the Garden City Skyway Bridge in St. Catharines to the Golf Course. **DO NOT** take Hwy 405 to Queenston Heights!




