ASHRAE Hamilton Chapter Golf Tournament Update

Thanks to all who have signed up for our upcoming ASHRAE Hamilton Chapter Golf Tournament—at the Legends on the Niagara / Battlefield Course—on Wednesday, June 4th. Our second time at this course.

Last year we had 116 golfers . . . a record. This year we are dangerously close to 120. I can go over 120 so, please, if you are still contemplating . . . let me know ASAP.

Again, it's a 1 p.m. shotgun start. We have a number of people who have never been to our tournament. Directions are included in this Airways Bulletin. When you enter at the main entrance, someone will stop your vehicle and place yours clubs on the correct cart. Park your vehicle and a shuttle will bring you back to the clubhouse. You CANNOT take your cart anywhere until the Marshall directs you to your start hole . . . mainly because the keys will be missing!

I will be sending the "contact name" listed on the entry form additional details regarding their starting hole. Your scorecard will also have your first hole highlighted. This is a scramble format meaning that, after each shot, you go to the best ball. Where it gets tricky is you must use 3 drives each. Any other rules will be given out on June 4th including the longest drive hole. To keep track of drives, please mark your score for the hole, next to the person whose drive you used.

Like last year, on ALL PAR 3's, if you hit and stay on the green, write your name on the clipboard located next to the green (Tee shot only!) During supper, one name from each Par 3 will win a prize.

Hole #17 (A difficult Par 3 . . . yes that is water and not a mirage!) will be our ASHRAE Research Hole. If you hit and stay on the green, you will win \$5. If you miss, your \$5 goes to ASHRAE Research. Please be courteous to Sara Toms, from Johnson Controls, who has donated her time to be my "watchful eye" Like the other Par 3's, add your name to the clipboard if you stay on the green.

Special Thanks to our Hole Sponsors. Further recognition will take place at the supper. Look for the signs posted at the T boxes. They are a huge part of the success of our Tournament and have helped keep our costs down.

Directions to Legends on the Niagara

Follow the QEW toward Fort Erie.

Exit at Lyons Creek Road (Exit 21). After you exit the highway, turn left (East) at the stop sign (crossing back over the QEW)

Follow past the small town of Chippawa (smaller than Delhi!) Stay on this road until it ends at the Niagara

River. Veer to the right and follow along the Niagara Parkway for 4km's. The entrance is on the right. The driveway to the clubhouse is approximately 1 km. Someone from the course will stop your car and unload your clubs onto your designated cart. Proceed to parking lot where a shuttle will bring you back to the clubhouse.

Watch for the number of blue signs along the QEW. They will also direct you to the course.

It is approximately 30km from the Garden City Skyway Bridge in St. Catharines to the Golf Course. **DO NOT take Hwy 405 to Queenston Heights!** Once over the bridge....stay to your right toward Fort Erie.


