LEED for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance 2009 (LEED Canada EB:O&M)

LEED® is North America's most widely recognized green building rating system in the design and construction industry. While LEED® for New Construction and Major Renovations has been in the Canadian marketplace since 2004, existing buildings have had limited opportunity to quantify building improvements relating to sustainability. LEED Canada EB:O&M encourages owners and operators of existing buildings to implement sustainable operations and maintenance practices and to reduce the environmental impact of their buildings over their functional life cycles. This presentation will provide an overview of the LEED EBOM rating system and its impact on the HVAC & R industry.


